A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Beer, Wine and Liquor License**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain organization in Frederick County to obtain  
4 a license for the sale of beer, wine and liquor in Frederick County; specifying the  
5 use of the net proceeds from the sale of certain alcoholic beverages; and  
6 generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Frederick County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
8 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
9 Section 8-211(a)

12 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
13 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

20 8-211.

21 (a) The provisions of this section apply only in Frederick County.

22 (g) (1) The restrictions in this section and in § 7-101(g) of this article do not  
23 apply to licenses issued pursuant to this subsection.

24 (2) The following entities may obtain a license for the sale of beer, wine  
25 and liquor:

26 (i) Middletown Volunteer Fire Company;

- 1 (ii) Wolfsville Volunteer Fire Company;
- 2 (iii) Jefferson Volunteer Fire Company; [and]
- 3 (iv) Myersville Volunteer Fire Company; AND
- 4 (V) ST. KATHARINE DREXEL ROMAN CATHOLIC CONGREGATION,
- 5 INC.

6 (3) All net proceeds from the sale of alcoholic beverages for the entities  
 7 listed in paragraph (2)(I) THROUGH (IV) of this subsection shall be used solely to  
 8 purchase fire and rescue equipment, for operating expenses, and for constructing and  
 9 maintaining the buildings which house the emergency equipment.

10 (4) ALL NET PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES  
 11 FOR ST. KATHARINE DREXEL ROMAN CATHOLIC CONGREGATION, INC., UNDER  
 12 PARAGRAPH (2)(V) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED TO FUND BUILDING  
 13 CONSTRUCTION OR FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
 15 June 1, 2006.
