2 **Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Beer, Wine and Liquor License**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain organization in Frederick County to obtain  
4 a certain type of license for the sale of beer, wine and liquor in Frederick County;  
5 specifying the use of the net proceeds from the sale of certain alcoholic  
6 beverages; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Frederick  
7 County.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
 7 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 8-211(h) of Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages of the  
 8 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 8-211(i).

14 (a) The provisions of this section apply only in Frederick County.

15 (g) (1) The restrictions in this section and in § 7-101(g) of this article do not  
 16 apply to licenses issued pursuant to this subsection.

17 (2) The following entities may obtain a license for the sale of beer, wine  
 18 and liquor:

19 (i) Middletown Volunteer Fire Company;

20 (ii) Wolfsville Volunteer Fire Company;

21 (iii) Jefferson Volunteer Fire Company; {and}

22 (iv) Myersville Volunteer Fire Company; ~~AND~~

23 ~~(V) ST. KATHARINE DREXEL ROMAN CATHOLIC CONGREGATION,~~

25 (3) All net proceeds from the sale of alcoholic beverages for the entities  
 26 listed in paragraph (2)~~(I) THROUGH (IV)~~ of this subsection shall be used solely to  
 27 purchase fire and rescue equipment, for operating expenses, and for constructing and  
 28 maintaining the buildings which house the emergency equipment.

29 (H) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING THE RESTRICTIONS IN THIS SECTION AND IN §  
 30 7-101(G) OF THIS ARTICLE, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A  
 31 ONE-DAY SPECIAL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE TO ST. KATHARINE DREXEL  
 32 ROMAN CATHOLIC CONGREGATION, INC.

2 BUILDING CONSTRUCTION OR FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
4 June 1, 2006.
