3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions relating to a requirement that

4 counties and Baltimore City reimburse the Administrative Office of the Courts

5 for a certain percentage of the salary and other expenses for law clerks for

6 circuit court judges; requiring the counties and Baltimore City to continue to

7 reimburse the Administrative Office of the Courts for certain money that is

8 owed as of a certain date; providing that money in a certain fund will be

9 disbursed in a certain manner; requiring the Comptroller to withhold a certain

10 tax from a county or Baltimore City if the Administrative Office of the Courts

11 certifies that the county or Baltimore City is in arrears in paying the amounts

12 due under certain provisions of law as they were in effect on a certain date and

13 under this Act and to distribute the money to the Administrative Office of the

14 Courts in a certain amount; and generally relating to the funding for law clerks.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

23 2-512.

24 (a) Each circuit court judge shall have one law clerk, to be employed by the 25 State.

26 (b) The budget for the Administrative Office of the Courts shall include funds 27 to employ one law clerk for each circuit court judge.

1 [(c) (1) Each county and Baltimore City shall reimburse the Administrative 2 Office of the Courts for 25% of the salary and other expenses to employ one law clerk 3 for each circuit court judge in the county or Baltimore City.

4 (2) The amounts received under this subsection shall be credited to a 5 special fund, to be used only to provide funds to employ law clerks for each circuit 6 court judge as provided in this section.

7 (3) Notwithstanding Title 2, Subtitle 6 of the Tax - General Article, if the 8 Administrative Office of the Courts certifies to the Comptroller that a county or 9 Baltimore City is more than 90 days in arrears in paying the amounts due under this 10 subsection, the Comptroller shall withhold from the county income tax otherwise due 11 to be distributed to the county or Baltimore City and shall pay to the Administrative 12 Office of the Courts the amount due.]

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

14(1)the counties and Baltimore City shall continue to reimburse the15Administrative Office of the Courts for all money owed as of June 30, 2006, to the16special fund created under § 2-512(c)(2) of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings17Article as it was in effect on June 30, 2006; and

18 (2) any money remaining in the fund shall be disbursed as required by §
19 2-512(c) of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article as it was in effect on June 30,
20 2006.

21 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding Title 2,

22 Subtitle 6 of the Tax - General Article, if the Administrative Office of the Courts

23 certifies to the Comptroller that a county or Baltimore City is more than 90 days in

24 arrears in paying the amounts due under § 2-512(c) of the Courts and Judicial

25 Proceedings Article as it was in effect on June 30, 2006, or under Section 2 of this Act,

26 the Comptroller shall withhold from the county income tax otherwise due to be

27 distributed to the county or Baltimore City and shall pay to the Administrative Office

28 of the Courts the amount due.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJuly 1, 2006.
