- 24 INDIVIDUAL, BY TELEPHONE, WRITTEN COMMUNICATION, ELECTRONIC MAIL, OR
- 25 ANY OTHER MEANS, FOR A PERIOD OF 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE SALE FOR
- 26 THE PURPOSE OF SELLING TO THE INDIVIDUAL ANY OTHER KIND OF INSURANCE
- 27 THAT THE INSURANCE PRODUCER IS LICENSED TO SELL IN THE STATE.
