6	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

	(a) The Administration shall continue to operate the following passenger railroad services at levels of service at least equivalent to the level of service established as of July 1, 1981:
23	(1) The CSX line between Brunswick and the District of Columbia;
24	(2) The Amtrak line between Penn Station in Baltimore and the District

- 3 (b) The Administration shall recover at least 50 percent of total operating

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 19 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 20 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 21 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 22 the date it is enacted.
