- 6 that is distributed for a certain purpose; specifying that the money distributed
- 7 under this Act is intended to provide additional revenue for public school
- 8 systems and may not supplant any other appropriation to public school systems;
- 9 defining a certain term; and generally relating to the distribution of lottery
- 10 proceeds to public school systems in the State.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

(b) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM" MEANS THE

18 BALTIMORE CITY.

(B) THE SHARE OF PROCEEDS TO WHICH AN INDIVIDUAL PUBLIC SCHOOL
