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## 2 Emergency Management - Evacuation Plans for Regulated Facilities

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring local organizations for emergency management to

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Public Safety
- 19 14-110.1.
- 20 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO NURSING HOMES, ASSISTED LIVING
- 21 FACILITIES, RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES FOR CHILDREN, AND OTHER REGULATED
- 22 FACILITIES THAT HOUSE THE ELDERLY, FRAIL, DISABLED, INDIVIDUALS WITH
- 23 SPECIAL NEEDS, AND CHILDREN WHO ARE DEPENDENT ON THEIR CAREGIVERS.
- 24 (B) EACH LOCAL ORGANIZATION FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SHALL
- 25 COORDINATE WITH EACH REGULATED FACILITY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF
- 26 THIS SECTION IN THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO ENSURE THAT:

- 1 (2) THE LOCAL ORGANIZATION FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT HAS A 2 COPY OF THE REGULATED FACILITY'S EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLAN.
- 3 (C) THE LOCAL ORGANIZATION FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SHALL:
- 4 (1) REVIEW THE EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLANS OF THE REGULATED
- 5 FACILITIES IN THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO PLAN FOR AND COORDINATE
- 6 RESOURCE ALLOCATION TO MEET THE EVACUATION NEEDS OF THE REGULATED
- 7 FACILITIES; AND
- 8 (2) CONSULT WITH LOCAL FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
- 9 AGENCIES AND PRIVATE AMBULANCE SERVICES TO ENSURE COORDINATION OF
- 10 MEDICAL TRANSPORT DURING AN EVACUATION OF A REGULATED FACILITY IN THE
- 11 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 2006.
