1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County - Highways - Prohibition on Use for Solicitation**
3 **MC 606-06**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from standing in a roadway, median divider,
5 or intersection in Montgomery County to solicit money or donations from an
6 occupant of a vehicle; and generally relating to restrictions on the use of
7 highways in Montgomery County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Transportation**

16 21-507.

17 (c) In Carroll County, Charles County, Frederick County, Harford County,
18 MONTGOMERY COUNTY, and Washington County, a person may not stand in a
19 roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind
20 from the occupant of a vehicle.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2006.
