5 (e) In Carroll County, Charles County, Frederick County, Harford County,
6 MONTGOMERY COUNTY, and Washington County, a person may not stand in a

7 roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind

9 (G) (1) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS
10 MAY NOT STAND IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION TO SOLICIT
11 MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.

15 (H) IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS MAY
 16 NOT STAND IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION TO SOLICIT MONEY
 17 OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.
