- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 Article Health General

- 24 (A) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH STAKEHOLDER GROUPS
- 25 REPRESENTING THE ASSISTED LIVING INDUSTRY, SHALL DEVELOP A STANDARD
- 26 ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM SERVICES DISCLOSURE STATEMENT.
- 27 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM SERVICES DISCLOSURE
- 28 STATEMENT IS TO INFORM POTENTIAL CONSUMERS ABOUT THE SERVICES

- 1 PROVIDED BY AN ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM IN ORDER TO ASSIST A CONSUMER IN
- 2 CHOOSING THE MOST APPROPRIATE ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM.
- 3 (C) (1) AN ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM, AS PART OF THE APPLICATION FOR
- 4 LICENSURE, SHALL FILE WITH THE OFFICE OF HEALTH CARE QUALITY THE
- 5 ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM SERVICES DISCLOSURE STATEMENT DEVELOPED BY

- 7 (2) IF AN ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM CHANGES THE SERVICES

- 10 QUALITY AN AMENDED ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM SERVICES DISCLOSURE
- 11 STATEMENT WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE CHANGE IN SERVICES.
- 12 (D) IF AN INDIVIDUAL REQUESTS A COPY OF AN ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM'S
- 13 SERVICES DISCLOSURE STATEMENT, THE ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM SHALL
- 14 PROVIDE A COPY OF THE SERVICES DISCLOSURE STATEMENT TO THE INDIVIDUAL
- 15 MAKING THE REQUEST.
- 16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- 17 (a) The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in coordination with the
- 18 Oversight Committee on Quality of Care in Nursing Homes and Assisted-Living
- 19 Facilities, the Department of Aging, providers, advocates, and other State and local
- 20 stakeholders, shall develop a process to educate consumers regarding the assisted
- 21 living program services disclosure statement; and
- 22 (b) On or before December 30, 2007, the Department of Health and Mental
- 23 Hygiene shall report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and
- 24 Government Operations Committee in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State
- 25 Government Article, on:
- 26 (1) The number of requests received from consumers for the assisted
- 27 living program services disclosure statement;
- 28 (2) The resources required to make the assisted living program services
- 29 disclosure statement available on-line; and
- 30 (3) The process to educate consumers developed under subsection (a) of
- 31 this section.
- 32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 33 July 1, 2006.
