1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws - Stopping, Standing, or Parking After Turning - Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from stopping, standing, or parking a vehicle
4 on a highway within a certain distance of an intersection after making a turn
5 from another highway; and generally relating to stopping, standing, or parking
6 a vehicle on a highway.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article - Transportation**

20 21-1003.

21 (a) The provisions of this section apply except as necessary to avoid conflict
22 with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or
23 traffic control device.

24 (FF) A PERSON MAY NOT STOP, STAND, OR PARK A VEHICLE ON A HIGHWAY
25 WITHIN 100 FEET OF AN INTERSECTION AFTER MAKING A TURN FROM ANOTHER
26 HIGHWAY.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2006.
