9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "LONG-TERM SUBSTITUTE TEACHER" MEANS A
14 SUBSTITUTE TEACHER WHO TEACHES MORE THAN 30 DAYS, BASED ON EQUIVALENT
15 HOURS, PER SCHOOL YEAR IN THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM.

16 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD
17 SHALL ESTABLISH EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR LONG-TERM SUBSTITUTE
18 TEACHERS.

19 (C) (1) ALL LONG-TERM SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM 20 OF AN ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE ON OR BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF THE 2007 SCHOOL 21 YEAR.

(2) ALL LONG-TERM SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM
OF A BACHELOR'S DEGREE ON OR BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF THE 2009 SCHOOL
YEAR.

(D) A WAIVER FROM THE REQUIREMENTS IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS
 SECTION MAY BE GRANTED TO LONG-TERM SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS WITH:

29 (C) (1) ALL LONG-TERM SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM

32 (2) ALL LONG-TERM SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM
33 OF A BACHELOR'S DEGREE ON OR BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF THE 2009 SCHOOL
34 YEAR.

(D) A WAIVER FROM THE REQUIREMENTS IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS
 SECTION MAY BE GRANTED TO LONG-TERM SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS WITH:

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(1) 5 YEARS' TEACHING EXPERIENCE; AND

15 <u>AND SENATE DELEGATIONS:</u>

21 (F) THE BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH A PARTNERSHIP WITH THE PRINCE
22 GEORGE'S COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN ORDER TO ASSIST LONG-TERM
23 SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS CURRENTLY ATTENDING PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY
24 COMMUNITY COLLEGE WITH:

25 (1) RECEIVING CREDIT FOR WORK EXPERIENCE AND ON-THE-JOB
 26 PERFORMANCE; AND

27 (2) SEEKING STATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall
take effect on the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 20 of
Chapter 289 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002. If that termination provision
takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions
 of Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006.
