- 3 30, 2007, the Department of Natural Resources shall conduct a study by December 31,
- 4 2007, on the effectiveness of Sunday hunting as a means of reducing the deer
- 5 population, and reducing the threat to public health and safety caused by the
- 6 overpopulation of deer in Montgomery County. In accordance with § 2-1246 of the
- 7 State Government Article, the Department of Natural Resources shall report the
- 8 findings of the study to the House Environmental Matters Committee, the Senate
- 9 Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee, and the Montgomery

- 25 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 3 months and, at
- 27 the end of December 31, 2008, with no further action required by the General
- 28 Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
