1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages in Unlicensed Establishments**
3 **PG 322-06**

4 FOR the purpose of making it a misdemeanor for a person who operates a business
5 establishment for profit in Prince George's County to knowingly allow customers
6 to bring alcoholic beverages for consumption into the establishment; specifying a
7 certain penalty; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Prince George's
8 County.

10 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

17 20-108.1.

18 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.

19 (B) A PERSON WHO OPERATES A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT FOR PROFIT
20 THAT IS NOT LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE MAY NOT KNOWINGLY ALLOW
21 CUSTOMERS TO BRING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION INTO THE
22 ESTABLISHMENT.

23 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
24 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 June 1, 2006.
