(D) IF THE APPLICANT IS CERTIFIED TO PRACTICE AS A SUPERVISED
28 COUNSELOR-ALCOHOL AND DRUG, THE BOARD MAY GRANT A WAIVER UNDER THIS
29 SECTION ONLY IF THE APPLICANT:

31 THAT HAS REQUIREMENTS THAT EQUAL ARE EQUIVALENT TO OR EXCEED THE
