21 (i) (1) An employer or other party may pay for the costs borne by the 22 employee or other individual under subsection (h) of this section.

24 (i) an adult residing in a foster care home for the costs borne by the 25 individual under subsection (h) of this section; and

26 (ii) an individual described in subsection (c)(4)(ii) of this section for 27 the costs borne by the individual under subsection (h) of this section.
