3 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "OWNER" INCLUDES A PERSON WHO IS A LESSEE OF A
4 MOTOR VEHICLE UNDER A WRITTEN LEASE THAT IS FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST 90
5 DAYS.

6 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A RECORDING DEVICE COMMONLY REFERRED 7 TO AS AN "EVENT DATA RECORDER" OR A "SENSING AND DIAGNOSTIC MODULE" 8 THAT:

9 (1) IS INSTALLED IN A MOTOR VEHICLE BY THE MANUFACTURER OF 10 THE MOTOR VEHICLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF RETRIEVING DATA AFTER AN ACCIDENT; 11 AND

12 (2) DOES AT LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

13 (I) RECORDS THE MOTOR VEHICLE'S SPEED AND DIRECTION;

14 (II) RECORDS WHERE THE MOTOR VEHICLE TRAVELS;

1 (2) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION, FOR THE PURPOSE 2 OF IMPROVING MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY, INCLUDING MEDICAL RESEARCH ON THE 3 RESPONSE OF A HUMAN BODY INVOLVED IN A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT;

4 (3) ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF DIAGNOSING, SERVICING, OR
5 REPAIRING MOTOR VEHICLES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DIAGNOSING, SERVICING, OR
6 REPAIRING THE MOTOR VEHICLE UNDER AN AGREEMENT WITH AN OWNER OF THE

(3) A DISCLOSURE OF A VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER WITH THE

(B) A MANUFACTURER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE SOLD OR LEASED IN THE STATE
THAT IS EQUIPPED WITH A RECORDING DEVICE AS DEFINED IN § 10-313 OF THE
COURTS ARTICLE SHALL DISCLOSE IN THE OWNER'S MANUAL FOR THE MOTOR
VEHICLE THE FACT THAT THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS EQUIPPED WITH A RECORDING
DEVICE.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be

2 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have

3 any effect on or application to any data stored on a recording device in a motor vehicle

4 involved in an accident before the effective date of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2006.
