1 (III) The Sheriff may appoint deputy sheriffs and other personnel

2 necessary to perform the duties of office at salary levels set by the County

3 Commissioners in accordance with the county's budgetary process.

4 (2) (I) Any deputy sheriff appointed according to this [section]

5 SUBSECTION shall be placed on a probationary status for the first [year] TWO YEARS
6 of his employment, and may be dismissed by the Sheriff for any reason during that
7 probationary period.

8 (II) At the conclusion of [twelve months'] continuous employment
9 FOR TWO YEARS, a deputy sheriff having the rank of [lieutenant] MAJOR or below
10 has tenure, and may be discharged by the Sheriff only for misfeasance, malfeasance,
11 nonfeasance, or insubordination in office.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2006.
