- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

- 17 (a) The entire area of Montgomery County is within the regional district,
- 18 subject to the provisions of § 7-105 of this title.
- 19 (b) The entire area of Prince George's County is within the regional district,
- 20 with the exception of the City of Laurel, as its corporate boundaries are defined as of
- 21 July 1, [1994] 2006, OR AS MODIFIED ON ANY SUBSEQUENT DATE. A municipal
- 22 corporation within the areas added by this subsection to the Maryland-Washington
- 23 Regional District is not authorized, by means of an amendment to its charter or
- 24 otherwise, to exercise any of the powers relating to planning, subdivision control, or
- 25 zoning granted by the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission or
- 26 the County Council of Prince George's County. If this subsection for any reason is held
- 27 by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, it is declared to be the intention

- 1 of the General Assembly that this subsection is severable and that the remaining2 portions of this subsection would have been enacted without the invalid portions.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 July 1, 2006.
