- 5 (d) A caterer's license issued under this section authorizes the holder to
- 6 provide alcoholic beverages at events that are held off [the Class B restaurant or
- 7 hotel (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor licensel premises LICENSED AS A CLASS B
- 8 RESTAURANT OR HOTEL OR A CLASS D ESTABLISHMENT.
- 9 (e) The holder shall provide food as well as alcoholic beverages for 10 consumption at the catered event.
- 11 (f) A holder may exercise the privileges under [this] A CATERER'S license only

- 15 (g) This section does not require a holder of an existing Class B restaurant or
- 16 hotel (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor license OR CLASS D BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR
