- 3 (a) (1) The WSSC may adopt [rules and] regulations that the WSSC
- 4 considers necessary or desirable for the [construction, installation, and equipment]
- 5 INSTALLATION of FUEL gas [fixtures, devices,] PIPING, APPLIANCES,
