3 Article 29 - Washington Suburban Sanitary District

- The WSSC may adopt [rules and] regulations that the WSSC 5 (a) (1)
- 6 considers necessary or desirable for the [construction, installation, and equipment]
- 7 INSTALLATION of FUEL gas [fixtures, devices,] PIPING, APPLIANCES,
- 8 APPURTENANCES, and connections from the [outlet of the meter] POINT OF SERVICE
