5 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the District Council of the Maryland-National
 6 Capital Park and Planning Commission in Prince George's County from
 7 approving a special exception to construct certain liquefied natural gas storage
 8 facilities unless certain circumstances are met; and generally relating to the
 9 approval of liquefied natural gas storage facilities.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
 11 Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission
 12 Section 8-110.2
 13 Annotated Code of Maryland
 14 (2003 Replacement Volume and 2005 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission**

18 8-110.2.

19 The District Council of Prince George's County may not approve a special
 20 exception to construct or operate [a rubble landfill] THE FOLLOWING at a site
 21 without a three-fourths majority vote of the District Council:

1 (1) A RUBBLE LANDFILL; OR

2 (2) A LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS STORAGE FACILITY THAT CAN HOLD
3 MORE THAN 5,000 GALLONS OF LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 June 1, 2006.
