11 exempting certain agricultural buildings from certain requirements of the

12 Standards and other building codes; requiring the Department of Housing and

5 <u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the General Assembly</u>

6 encourages the University of Maryland, through the Maryland Cooperative Extension

7 Services, to develop an educational program that focuses on liability issues for

8 farmers that have farms engaged in agritourism.
