- 3 FOR the purpose of classifying black bears as nongame mammals; prohibiting the
- 4 Department of Natural Resources from reducing the black bear population in

- 17 (f) "Forest game birds and mammals" means forest game birds (ruffed grouse
- 18 and turkey) and forest game mammals ([black bears,] deer, fox squirrels, excluding
- 19 the Delmarva subspecies, and gray and red squirrels) or any part, egg, offspring, or
- 20 dead body of any of them.
- 21 10-206.
- 22 (A) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE
- 23 Department may reduce the wildlife population in any county, election district, or
- 24 other identifiable area of the State after a thorough investigation reveals that
- 25 protected wildlife is seriously injurious to agricultural or other interests in the
- 26 affected area. The method of reducing the wildlife population is at the Department's
