BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Natural Resources** 16 10-604. 17 (a) A person may hunt wild waterfowl while standing in water on the natural 18 bottom only in the waters of the Susquehanna Flats, the nontidal waters of the 19 Potomac River, and in other waters of the State in areas and on days the Department 20 prescribes by regulation. 21 A person may hunt wild waterfowl while standing in water on the natural

22 bottom at a licensed offshore stationary blind or blind site.

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A person hunting wild waterfowl while standing in water on the natural

2 bottom shall remain at least 250 yards from all offshore stationary blinds or blind sites or another person hunting wild waterfowl offshore. A person hunting wild waterfowl while standing in water on the 4 (d) 5 natural bottom shall be at least 800 yards from shore including shore emerging at 6 mean low water except in the waters of the Potomac River, in the waters of the Susquehanna Flats, IN THE WATERS OF HARFORD AND BALTIMORE COUNTIES, or 8 while hunting at a licensed stationary blind or blind site. 9 A person hunting wild waterfowl while standing in water on the 10 natural bottom shall be at least 400 yards from shore, including shore emerging at mean low water, in the following areas: 12 (i) The waters of the Susquehanna Flats; [and] 13 The tidal waters of the Potomac River that the Department by (ii) 14 regulation prescribes for hunting under subsection (a) of this section; AND THE WATERS OF HARFORD AND BALTIMORE COUNTIES THAT 15 (III) 16 THE DEPARTMENT BY REGULATION PRESCRIBES FOR HUNTING UNDER SUBSECTION 17 (A) OF THIS SECTION. A person may not hunt wild waterfowl while standing in State waters on 18 19 the natural bottom when the natural bottom is privately owned, unless the hunter 20 has the written permission of the landowner. 21 Except at a licensed stationary blind or blind site, a nonresident may not (f) 22 hunt wild waterfowl while standing in water on the natural bottom unless 23 accompanied by a Maryland resident. 24 10-605. 25 A person may hunt wild waterfowl from a boat that is drifting or being (a) 26 sculled, only in: The nontidal waters of the Potomac River, Conococheague Creek, and 27 (1) 28 the Monocacy River; The Susquehanna Flats, Elk River, and that portion of the Sassafras 30 River in Cecil County located west of 75 degrees 58 minutes 45 seconds; 31 (3) Chincoteague Bay, Sinepuxent Bay, Isle of Wight, Assawoman Bay, 32 and their respective tributaries in Worcester County; or 33 (4) Zones prescribed by the Department by regulation. 34 While hunting wild waterfowl from a boat that is drifting or being sculled, 35 a person shall remain at least 250 yards from all offshore stationary blinds or blind 36 sites or another person hunting wild waterfowl offshore.

	(e) Except at a licensed stationary blind or blind site, a nonresident may not hunt wild waterfowl from a boat that is anchored unless accompanied by a Maryland resident.
