- 20 (2) "COCKFIGHT" MEANS A DELIBERATELY CONDUCTED EVENT THAT
- 21 USES A FOWL, COCK, OR OTHER BIRD TO FIGHT WITH ANOTHER FOWL, COCK, OR

- 23 (3) "DEPICTION" MEANS A VISUAL OR AUDITORY RECORDING OR
