## A BILL ENTITLED

## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Creation of a State Debt - Maryland Affordable Housing Trust

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- \$3,000,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the 4
- 5 Maryland Affordable Housing Trust, Inc. for certain development or
- improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; 6
- establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds; 7
- 8 and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

## 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 10 MARYLAND, That:
- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Maryland
- 13 Affordable Housing Trust Loan of 2006 in the total principal amount of \$3,000,000.
- 14 This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general
- 15 obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued,
- 16 sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance
- 17 and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 18 (2)The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 19 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 20 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 21 The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer (3)
- 22 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 23 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 24 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 25 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 26 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Maryland
- 27 Affordable Housing Trust, Inc. to be used for awards to help acquire, build,
- 28 rehabilitate, and preserve affordable housing and to help nonprofit organizations

- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and
- 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 (5) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of
- 8 Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, 2013. If any
- 9 funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1,
- 10 2013, the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be
- 11 canceled and be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the
- 12 amount of unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as
- 13 provided in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 15 June 1, 2006.
