- [When] EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, WHEN the 20
- 21 license issued under the provisions of this article has been revoked, such licensee
- 22 shall not at any time thereafter be entitled to obtain any other license under the
- 23 provisions of this article, and no other person shall be entitled to obtain such a license
- 24 for the same premises until after the expiration of six months from the date of such
- 25 revocation and not at all in the discretion of said Comptroller, board of license
- 26 commissioners for the city or county, court or State Appeal Board as the case may be.
- 27 If the license was held on behalf of a corporation, partnership, or unincorporated
- 28 association, no person until after the expiration of said six-month period shall be
- 29 entitled to obtain another license on behalf of such corporation, partnership, or
