17 (A) A PERSON IN THE BUSINESS OF BREEDING, DISTRIBUTING, OR AIDING IN18 THE WHOLESALE OR RETAIL DISTRIBUTION OF FERRETS:

19 (1) MAY NOT TRANSPORT, SELL, OR OFFER FOR SALE A FERRET THAT:

20 (I) IS LESS THAN 10 WEEKS OLD; OR

21 (II) HAS NOT BEEN SPAYED OR NEUTERED, UNLESS THE FERRET IS 22 TRANSPORTED, SOLD, OR OFFERED FOR SALE TO A FERRET BREEDER;

(3) MAY NOT TRANSPORT, SELL, OR OFFER FOR SALE A FERRET THAT
 HAS BEEN SPAYED OR NEUTERED UNTIL MORE THAN 7 DAYS AFTER THE

4 (4) SHALL PROVIDE CERTIFICATION DATING ANY PROCEDURE TO SPAY 5 OR NEUTER A FERRET.

6 (B) A PERSON IN THE BUSINESS OF BREEDING, DISTRIBUTING, OR AIDING IN
