3 **Premises of Off-Sale Licensees**

5 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an alcoholic beverages licensee in Prince George's
6 County whose license confers off-sale privileges from placing a sign of any type
7 in or on an exterior window of the licensed premises; specifying a certain
8 penalty; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Prince George's County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

22 9-217.

23 (a) This section applies only in Prince George's County.

24 (N) (1) A LICENSEE WHOSE LICENSE CONFERS OFF-SALE PRIVILEGES MAY
25 NOT PLACE A SIGN OF ANY TYPE IN OR ON AN EXTERIOR WINDOW OF THE LICENSED
26 PREMISES.

1 (2) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE
2 THE LICENSE OF A LICENSEE THAT VIOLATES THIS SUBSECTION.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 2006.
