A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Class B Beer and Light Wine Licenses - Gateway**
3 **Arts and Entertainment District**
4 **PG 311-06**

5 FOR the purpose of increasing the number of Class B beer and light wine licenses
6 allowed to be issued in Prince George's County; authorizing the Board of License
7 Commissioners to issue a Class B beer and light wine license in a certain
8 location; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince
9 George's County.

25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
26 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

2 9-217.

3 (a) This section applies only in Prince George's County.

4 (b) The number of licenses of each class of alcoholic beverage licenses may not
5 exceed the following maximum amounts:

6 (6) Beer and light wine license, Class B [38] 39

7 (l) (1) The Board of License Commissioners may not issue any new beer,
8 wine or liquor licenses that have an off-sale privilege within, or transfer any
9 additional beer, wine or liquor licenses that have an off-sale privilege into the
10 boundaries of the 21st (that part located within the county), 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th,
11 26th, 27th (that part located within the county), or 47th alcoholic beverages district as
12 follows:13 (ii) The 22nd alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
14 coterminous with the 22nd legislative district in Prince George's County. As ordered
15 by the Maryland Court of Appeals on June 21, 2002, the 22nd alcoholic beverages
16 district consists of:

- 17 1. Prince George's County election district 19;
- 18 2. Prince George's County election district 2, precincts 6 and
19 10;
- 20 3. Prince George's County election district 14, precinct 8;
- 21 4. Prince George's County election district 16, precincts 2
22 through 5;
- 23 5. Prince George's County election district 17, precincts 9
24 and 12;
- 25 6. Prince George's County election district 20, precincts 1, 2,
26 6, 7, and 11;
- 27 7. Prince George's County election district 21, precincts 3, 6
28 through 9, 11 through 13, and 16;
- 29 8. That part of Prince George's County election district 2,
30 precinct 5 consisting of the following census tracts and blocks:
 - 31 A. Census tract 8039.00, blocks 1000 through 1013, 2000
32 through 2007, and 3000 through 3015;
 - 33 B. Census tract 8040.01, blocks 2001 and 2002; and

1 C. Census tract 8040.02, blocks 1003, 1010, 2000 through
2 2002, and 2004;

3 9. That part of Prince George's County election district 2,
4 precinct 8 consisting of census tract 8063.00, block 2016;

5 10. That part of Prince George's County election district 16,
6 precinct 1 consisting of the following census tracts and blocks:

7 A. Census tract 8040.02, blocks 2049 and 2995;

8 B. Census tract 8063.00, blocks 1000, 1012 through 1035,
9 1996 through 1999, 2001, 2003 through 2015, and 2997 through 2999; and

10 C. Census tract 8065.01, blocks 2996, 2997, 3011 through
11 3015, 3996, and 3997; and

12 11. That part of Prince George's County election district 21,
13 precinct 10 consisting of the following census tracts and blocks:

14 A. Census tract 8067.03, block 1001; and

15 B. Census tract 8074.08, block 4014;

16 (L-1) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A CLASS B BEER
17 AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE IN THE GATEWAY ARTS AND ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT
18 IN THE 22ND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES DISTRICT.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 June 1, 2006.
