- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "MANUFACTURED HOME" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN 20 § 12-301 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE.
- 21 (B) A home builder [who] THAT installs A NEW HOME THAT IS an
- 22 industrialized building intended for residential use, A MANUFACTURED HOME, or a
- 23 mobile home is responsible to the owner for correcting any defects in any component
- 24 incorporated into the new home [except for those industrialized buildings or mobile
- 25 homes that are], REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE NEW HOME IS the responsibility of
- 26 the manufacturer [of the industrialized building and mobile home] pursuant to Title
- 27 12, Subtitle 3 of the Public Safety Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 2006.
