FOR the purpose of requiring a candidate for County Commissioner of Frederick County to have been a resident and registered voter of Frederick County for a certain minimum time immediately preceding the election; prohibiting a County Commissioner who no longer resides in the County from continuing as a County Commissioner; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the County Commissioners of Frederick County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
16 Article 11 - Frederick County
17 2-2-19.
18 (A) A CANDIDATE FOR COUNTY COMMISSIONER SHALL HAVE BEEN BE A 19 RESIDENT AND REGISTERED VOTER OF FREDERICK COUNTY FOR AT LEAST 6 20 MONTHS IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE DATE OF ELECTION.

- 21 (B) A COUNTY COMMISSIONER WHO NO LONGER RESIDES IN FREDERICK
- 22 COUNTY MAY NOT CONTINUE AS A COUNTY COMMISSIONER.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 3 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 4 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 5 the date it is enacted.
