22 IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SUBSIDY PAYMENT UNDER THIS (B) 23 SECTION, A GRANDPARENT CAREGIVER MUST:

(D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH 31 32 ELIGIBILITY AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS, CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF 33 THIS SECTION.
