4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and

5 Pension System to accept certain applications for special disability retirement

27 (3) The special disability allowance granted under this subsection shall
28 include all cost-of-living adjustments from December 30, 1982.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 July 1, 2006.
