FOR the purpose of altering the <u>maximum</u> number of certain positions to be appointed by the Baltimore City Sheriff is authorized to appoint; and generally relating to the Baltimore City Sheriff's office.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 (d) (1) (i) In Baltimore City, the Sheriff shall receive an expense 16 allowance of \$750 two times per year and a salary of:

Shall appoint an undersheriff or chief deputy sheriff, 9 fone TWO assistant sheriff SHERIFFS, two deputy sheriff majors, two deputy 10 sheriff captains, four TWELVE deputy sheriff lieutenants, four deputy sheriff 11 sergeants, one secretary sheriff, and one fiscal clerk sheriff; and 12 2. May appoint a total of UP TO A MAXIMUM OF: 13 67 DEPUTY SHERIFF SERGEANTS; AND <u>A.</u> 14 <u>B.</u> [83] 103 88 <u>90</u> deputy sheriffs. 15 (iii) 1. Except for deputy sheriffs, deputy sheriff sergeants, and 16 deputy sheriff lieutenants, salaries for these employees shall be set by the Secretary of Budget and Management. 18 Salaries for deputy sheriffs shall be set at a rate not less 19 than the salary equivalent to grade 14 of the State pay scale. 20 3. Salaries for deputy sheriff sergeants shall be set at a rate 21 not less than the salary equivalent to grade 16 of the State pay scale. 22 Salaries for deputy sheriff lieutenants shall be set at a 4. rate not less than the salary equivalent to grade 18 of the State pay scale. In addition to any other compensation received, each deputy 24 (iv) 25 sheriff shall receive an expense allowance of \$200 annually for: 1. Ammunition for practice sessions at the range; 26 Clothing allowance to defray the cost of dry cleaning and 27 2. 28 maintaining the clothing worn while on duty; and 29 3. The purchase and maintenance of other items necessary to 30 fulfill duties that currently are not furnished by the Baltimore City Sheriff's 31 Department. A deputy sheriff who uses a personal automobile is entitled to a 32

- 1 Sheriff who is assigned a city-owned automobile may not receive the monthly
- 2 automobile expense allowance.
- 3 (vi) The Sheriff's office shall also have assistants at the
- 4 compensation provided for in the annual ordinance of estimates of Baltimore City.
- 5 Provisions shall also be made in the ordinance for the expenses of the office of the
- 6 Sheriff, including the purchase and maintenance of motor vehicles.
- 7 (vii) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore have the same power
- 8 with respect to the salaries of the office of the Sheriff as they have under the city
- 9 charter with respect to the salaries of all municipal departments.
- 10 (viii) Employees of the Sheriff's office, except the Sheriff, shall be
- 11 selected according to the provisions of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 2006.
