- 2 Creation of a State Debt - Montgomery County - Montrose Center for 3 **Children and Families**
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- 5 \$350,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the
- Reginald S. Lourie Center for Infants and Young Children, Inc. for certain 6
- 7 development or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan
- 8 proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a
- matching fund; establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or expenditure of 9
- the loan proceeds; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds 10
- 11 evidencing the loan.
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That:
- 14 (1)The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 15 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Montgomery
- 16 County Montrose Center for Children and Families Loan of 2006 in the total
- principal amount of \$350,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and
- 18 delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of
- 19 Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 20 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 21 The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 22 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 23 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 24 The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 25 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 26 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 27 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 28 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 29 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Reginald S.
- 30 Lourie Center for Infants and Young Children, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act

- 1 as "the grantee") for the repair, renovation, and capital equipping of the Montrose
- 2 Center for Children and Families, an existing building located in Rockville.
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and
- 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 8 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 9 matching fund of \$200,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided,
- 10 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 11 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind
- 12 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any
- 13 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify
- 14 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the
- 15 Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2008, to present evidence
- 16 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If
- 17 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State
- 18 Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in
- 19 this Act.
- 20 (6) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of
- 21 Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, 2013. If any
- 22 funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1,
- 23 2013, the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be
- 24 canceled and be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the
- 25 amount of unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as
- 26 provided in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 28 June 1, 2006.
