18 education requirements of § 4-302 of the Health Occupations Article for applicants for
19 a limited license to practice dentistry who are contractually obligated to provide
20 pediatric dental services in a federally qualified health center or Maryland qualified
21 health center, terminates at the end of September 30, 2006.]
