1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 (a) If the Department applies for a Medical Assistance Program waiver or
6 modifies or amends an existing Medical Assistance Program waiver OR AMENDS THE

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(1) PUBLICATION in the Maryland Register; AND

10 (2) SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION OR AMENDMENT TO THE 11 MEDICAID ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR DISCUSSION AT A MEDICAID ADVISORY 12 COMMITTEE MEETING.

13 (b) For 30 days following publication of any notice published under subsection 14 (a) of this section, the Department shall:

15(1)Make the Medical Assistance Program waiver application OR16AMENDMENT TO THE MEDICAID STATE PLAN OR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM17available to the public during business hours; and

Provide an opportunity to receive public comments on the Medical
 Assistance Program waiver application OR AMENDMENT TO THE MEDICAID STATE
 PLAN OR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
