A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class 4 Manufacturer's (Limited**
3 **Winery) Licenses**

4 FOR the purpose of exempting a winery in Baltimore County that applies for a Class
5 4 manufacturer's (limited winery) license from any license quota established by
6 the Baltimore County Board of License Commissioners for the election district
7 in which the winery is located; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages
8 licenses in Baltimore County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

22 2-205.

23 (b) A Class 4 manufacturer's license:

24 (1) Is a limited winery license;

1 4-201.

2 (c) (1) A Class A light wine license may be issued by the license issuing
3 authority of the county in which the place of business is located to any holder of a
4 Class 4 manufacturer's license.

5 (2) A winery in Cecil County that applies for a Class A/Class 4 license is
6 exempt from any quotas established by the Cecil County Board of License
7 Commissioners as to the number of licenses in the election district where the winery
8 is located.

9 (3) A WINERY IN BALTIMORE COUNTY THAT APPLIES FOR A CLASS
10 A/CLASS 4 LICENSE IS EXEMPT FROM ANY QUOTAS ESTABLISHED BY THE BALTIMORE
11 COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS AS TO THE NUMBER OF LICENSES IN
12 THE ELECTION DISTRICT WHERE THE WINERY IS LOCATED.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
14 effect July 1, 2006.
