17 18	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 22	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "EMPLOYER" MEANS A PERSON ENGAGED IN A BUSINESS, INDUSTRY, PROFESSION, TRADE, OR OTHER ENTERPRISE IN THE STATE.
23	(2) "EMPLOYER" INCLUDES:
24	(I) THE STATE AND ITS UNITS;
25	(II) A COUNTY AND ITS UNITS; AND
