A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Transportation - Metrorail Green Line Extension to BWI - Study**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Transportation to conduct a certain
4 study of the expansion of the Green Line route of the Metrorail transit facility
5 from the Greenbelt station to the Baltimore-Washington International
6 Thurgood Marshall Airport; and generally relating to the Green Line Metrorail
7 transit facility.

11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (2001 Replacement Volume and 2005 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Transportation**

16 2-103.7.

17 USING EXISTING BUDGETED RESOURCES, THE SECRETARY SHALL CONDUCT A
18 STUDY OF THE NEED AND FEASIBILITY OF EXTENDING THE GREEN LINE ROUTE OF
19 THE METRORAIL TRANSIT FACILITY FROM THE GREENBELT METRORAIL STATION TO
20 THE BALTIMORE-WASHINGTON INTERNATIONAL THURGOOD MARSHALL AIRPORT.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
22 effect October 1, 2006.
