3 **Tasting License**4 FOR the purpose of altering the wine tasting license issued in Frederick County to be
5 a beer and wine sampling or tasting license; altering the annual fee of the
6 license; setting a certain limit on the quantity of a given brand of beer an
7 individual may consume at a beer and wine sampling or tasting event; repealing
8 a certain restriction on the number of certain events that may be held in a
9 licensing period; prohibiting sampling or tasting of beer to be conducted from a
10 drive-through window; making certain technical changes; and generally
11 relating to beer and wine sampling or tasting in Frederick County.12 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

16 (2005 Replacement Volume)17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:19 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

20 8-406.

21 (a) This section applies only in Frederick County.

1 (b) A BEER AND wine SAMPLING OR tasting [(WT)] (BWST) license may only
2 be issued to a holder of a Class A license.

3 (c) The annual license fee is [\$150] \$200.

4 (d) (1) Applications for a [WT] BWST license shall be made on forms
5 supplied by the Board of License Commissioners.

6 (2) Renewals of the license may be made at the time the regular license
7 is renewed.

8 (3) A license may be granted without a hearing.

9 (4) If application for a license is denied, the applicant may request a
10 public hearing before the Board.

11 (e) (1) [A WT licensee may not serve to any person for sampling or tasting
12 purposes more than one ounce from each brand.] A HOLDER OF A BWST LICENSE MAY
13 ALLOW CONSUMPTION BY A SINGLE INDIVIDUAL FOR SAMPLING OR TASTING
14 PURPOSES OF:

15 (I) NOT MORE THAN 1 OUNCE OF A GIVEN BRAND OF LIGHT WINE;
16 AND

17 (II) NOT MORE THAN 3 OUNCES OF A GIVEN BRAND OF BEER.

18 (2) A maximum of six bottles OF WINE may be opened at any one time.

19 [(2) A wine sampling or tasting event may not be held more than 15 days
20 each licensing period.]

21 (3) The licensee shall notify the Board in writing at least 5 days prior to
22 each event.

23 (4) Once opened, each bottle used for the BEER AND wine sampling or
24 tasting event shall be marked that it is to be used for that purpose only.

25 (5) The contents of each bottle may not be mixed with any other bottle
26 and all bottles shall be destroyed once they are empty.

27 (f) (1) A [WT] BWST license is for on-premises consumption only.

28 (2) [Wine sampling] SAMPLING or tasting OF BEER OR WINE may not be
29 conducted from a drive-through window.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
31 July 1, 2006.
