20 (2) A WAIVER APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE BOARD;

21 (3) PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY FOR THE APPLICABLE WAIVER; AND

22 (4) AN APPLICATION FOR THE APPLICABLE LICENSE IN ACCORDANCE 23 WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.

24 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall 25 take effect June 1, 2007.

26 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in

27 Section 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2006. Section 3 of this Act shall

28 remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2007, with no further

29 action required by the General Assembly, Section 3 of this Act shall be abrogated and 30 of no further force and effect.
