18 19	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
20	Article 20B - Tri-County Council for the Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland

22	(a) The membership of the Council consists of:
23	(1) Five county commissioners of Somerset County as voting members;
24	(2) Five county commissioners of Worcester County as voting members;
25 26	(3) [Five] THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND FOUR county council members of Wicomico County as voting members;

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1 (4) (i) Three municipal elected officials, one from each county, 2 appointed by their respective municipal corporations as voting members; or

3 (ii) If the municipal corporations located within a county are unable

4 to choose a municipal elected official within a reasonable period of time, the Eastern

5 Shore Municipal Association shall appoint an elected municipal official to represent

6 the municipal corporations of that county;

7 (5) Members of the General Assembly representing the region who have 8 a majority of their legislative district in the region as voting ex officio members;

9 (6) Other members of the General Assembly representing the region but 10 who do not have a majority of their legislative district in the region as nonvoting ex 11 officio members; and

12 (7) The other commissioners as ex officio nonvoting members.

13(b)(1)A voting commissioner listed under subsection (a)(1) through (3) of14this section may designate another commissioner or county administrator

15 representing the same county to vote by proxy on behalf of the voting commissioner

16 when the voting commissioner is absent from a meeting.

17 (2) A voting commissioner listed under subsection (a)(1) through (3) of
18 this section shall inform the council director in advance of which other council
19 member the voting commissioner designates to cast a proxy vote on behalf of the
20 voting commissioner.

21 (c) The bylaws of the Council may provide for additional private citizen22 membership on the Council.

(a) A member who holds membership by virtue of the member's electedposition holds office only during the member's term of office.

26 (b) Membership on the Council does not constitute holding an office of profit.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be

28 construed to extend or apply to the membership of the Tri-County Council for the

29 Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland in office on the effective date of this Act, but the 30 provisions of this Act concerning the membership of the Tri-County Council for the

31 Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland shall take effect at the beginning of the next

32 following term of office for the elected officials sitting as members of the Tri-County

33 Council for the Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland.

34 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 35 October 1, 2006.

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
