- 1 was employed as a desk officer or in any other position as a (i) 2 full-time or part-time permanent, temporary, or contractual State employee; and 3 (ii) was not a member of either the Employees' Retirement System 4 or the Employees' Pension System. Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, for service credit
- 6 granted under this Act, a year or part of a year of employment equals 1 year of service 7 credit.
