(B) UNTIL AT LEAST 2 YEARS HAVE PASSED AFTER LEAVING SERVICE WITH
THE COMMISSION AS THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, EXECUTIVE SECRETARY, OR
GENERAL COUNSEL, AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT:

4 (1) REPRESENT A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY BEFORE THE 5 COMMISSION;

6 (2) APPEAR BEFORE THE COMMISSION ON BEHALF OF A PARTY TO A 7 COMMISSION PROCEEDING; OR

8 (3) APPEAR BEFORE THE COMMISSION ON A MATTER WITHIN THE 9 JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSION.

10 [(b)] (C) Until at least 1 year has passed after leaving service with the 11 Commission as [the General Counsel or] a hearing examiner OR AS THE DIRECTOR 12 OF A COMMISSION STAFF DIVISION, an individual may not:

13 (1) represent a public service company before the Commission;

14 (2) appear before the Commission on behalf of a party to a Commission 15 proceeding; or

16 (3) appear before the Commission on a matter within the jurisdiction of 17 the Commission.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency

19 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,

20 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members

21 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from

22 the date it is enacted.
