18	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of 6 months and, at the end of December 31, 2006, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
