A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Department of Health and Mental Hygiene - On-Farm Food Processing**
3 **Facility - License and Fee**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain on-farm food processing facilities to obtain a
5 certain license for a certain fee each year; defining a certain term; and generally
6 relating to a license and fee for an on-farm food processing facility.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Health - General**

15 21-308.

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ON-FARM FOOD PROCESSING FACILITY" MEANS A
17 HOME OR DOMESTIC KITCHEN LOCATED ON AN INDIVIDUAL'S FARM THAT
18 MANUFACTURES AND PROCESSES FOODS FOR COMMERCIAL SALE.

19 [(a)] (B) (1) For any license issued for which the authority to conduct a
20 program under this subtitle has been delegated to a county health department:

21 (i) A county governing body or the Mayor and City Council of
22 Baltimore City may provide for a license fee schedule based on the anticipated cost of
23 licensing, inspecting, and regulating food establishments and may provide for
24 exemptions from the license fee schedule; and

25 (ii) All license fees shall be paid to the local health department or
26 chief financial officer of the county governing body or Baltimore City.

1 (2) Except in Baltimore City, Montgomery County, and Prince George's
2 County, a license fee under this subsection may not exceed:

3 (i) \$300; or

4 (ii) \$70 for a seasonal food processing operation that:

5 1. Uses only food that is grown on the property of the
6 licensee; and

7 2. Is in operation for not more than a 3-month continuous
8 period in the calendar year.

9 (3) A seasonal food processing operation may obtain a food establishment
10 license for a fee of \$70 under paragraph (2)(ii) of this subsection only twice in a
11 calendar year.

12 (C) (1) AN ON-FARM FOOD PROCESSING FACILITY MAY OBTAIN A FOOD
13 PROCESSING PLANT LICENSE FOR A FEE OF \$30 EACH YEAR.

14 (2) AN ON-FARM FOOD PROCESSING FACILITY THAT OBTAINS A FOOD
15 PROCESSING PLANT LICENSE MAY MANUFACTURE OR PROCESS ONLY FOODS THAT
16 ARE NONPOTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS AS DEFINED IN REGULATIONS OF THE
17 DEPARTMENT.

18 [(b)] (D) For any other food establishment license, the Secretary shall
19 establish a license fee in accordance with § 2-104 of this article.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2006.
